Safety in Car Parks

PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY IN THE CAR PARKS!

Recent monitoring of arrivals and departures in our car parks has revealed some very dangerous driving.

- The one way system, while improving flow and congestion, seems to have encouraged some parents to drive at unsafe speeds, particularly when arriving into the pre-school car park.
- We have also noticed that some drivers are entering the school car park against the no entry signs. This is extremely dangerous. Please use the one-way system.

WE EXPECT A SPEED LIMIT OF 5 MPH IN THE CAR PARKS.

Please remember that the car park areas are used by families on foot at all times of the day. Speed limit signs will be installed at the entrance in the new year.

The cost of a child meal will be increasing to £2.05 per meal from January 2019.

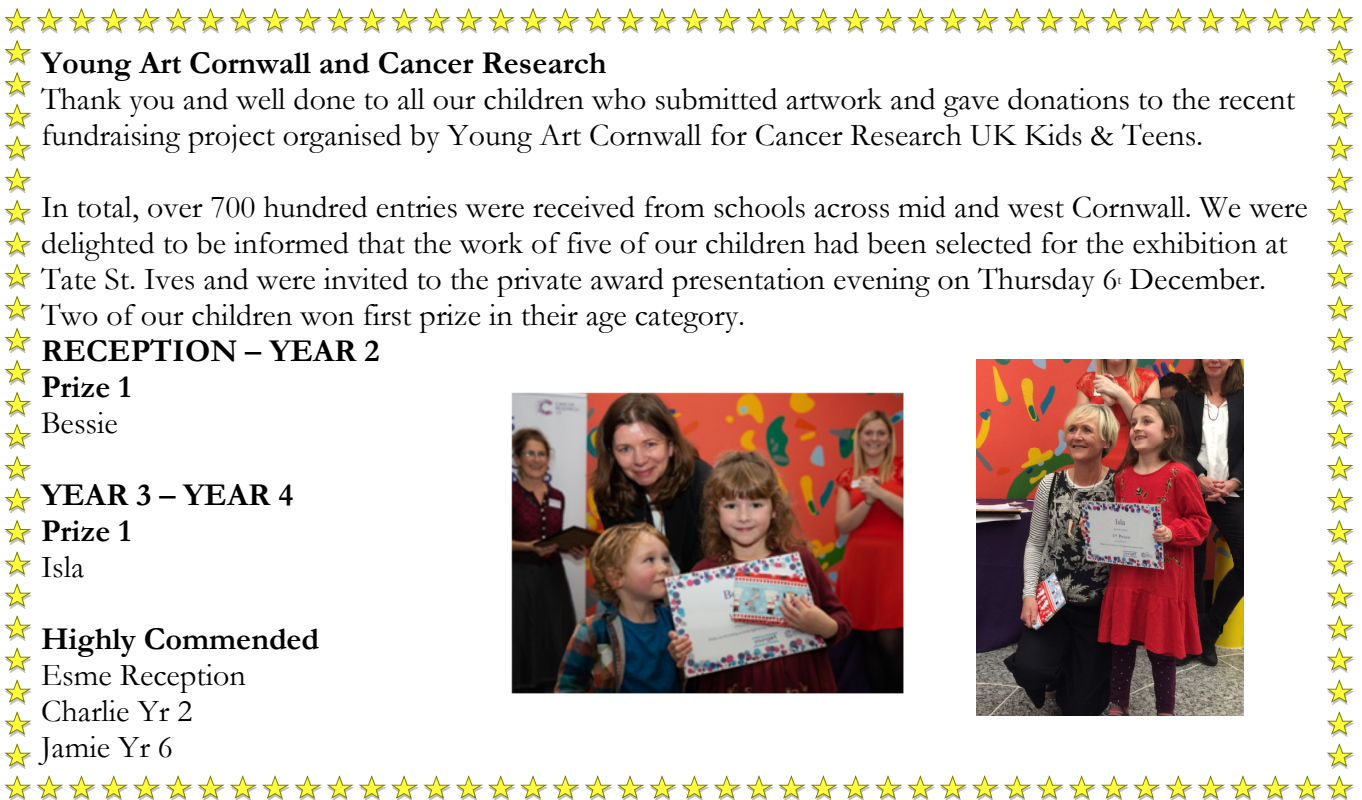
Football

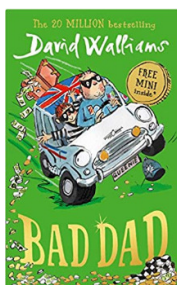
Wednesday - Football (years 3-6)
