- 500g see-through yoghurt pots to watch some beans grow.

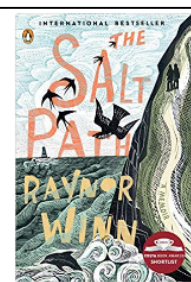

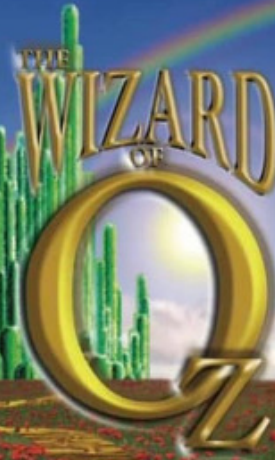
