
At the end of the trip we had the opportunity to build sandcastles and enjoy the play area.

They did some sketching of the old church and also took a traffic survey and decided it was far too busy for a small village!!




School Fruit

Music Lessons this term



Do you have a child born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018?

If so, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2022 for that child by the deadline of 15 January 2022.

Please note: you will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or pre-school class. If a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school.
