Class 3 Summer Performance at the Minack

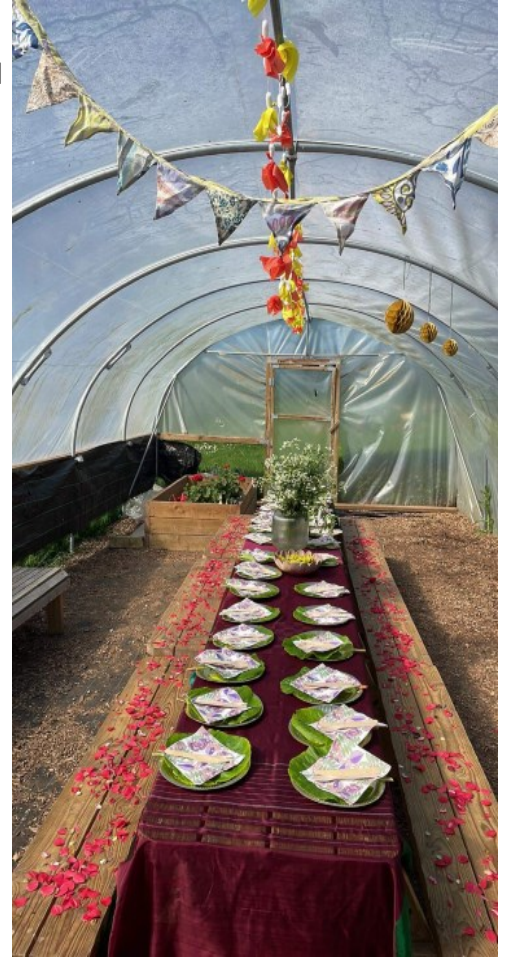

Dear Parents,

As you probably know, Basque/Spanish students have been coming to your school for many years to practice English and learn about Cornwall.

We are looking for hosts for either 2 boys or 2 girls from 1st July to 15th July. The students are 16/17 years old and will be at various schools in the area.

I must say they are all well behaved and like mixing with families. Their English is quite good so you won't need to speak Spanish. The idea is for them to become part of your family and speak as much English as possible. The first week that they arrive, they stay with us so will know how to get around. They are not allowed to go out at night unless with the family or the group. They will need a packed lunch and eat with you.

We give an allowance of £25 a night per student which comes to a total of £700 for the stay. During these 2 weeks we organize some activities together but the principle idea is for them to be with the families.
