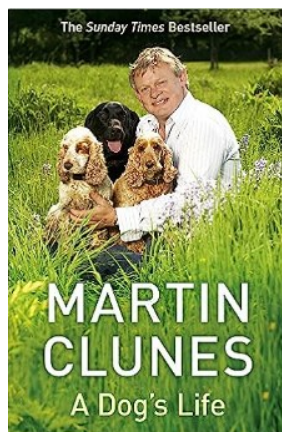


Class of ‘23 Themed Menu– **Action Required**
